WHO PROVIDES THE MEDICAL SUPPORT IN CASE OF A DIVING INJURY?

DAN Europe's 24/7 Call Center and Diving Medical Officers will assist you worldwide.

WHAT KIND OF DIVING ACTIVITIES ARE NOT COVERED?

- Technical Diving, i.e. Diving Activities with Gases such as Trimix (Nitrogen-Helium-Oxygen), Heliox (Helium – Oxygen) and any Diving Activities deeper than 40 Meters
- Overhead Environment, such as Cave Diving and Wreck Penetration Dives.

WHICH KIND OF DIVING ACTIVITIES I AM COVERED FOR?

- Any **recreational** Scuba Diving with compressed Air, but also enriched Air (EANx / Nitrox)
- Free Diving
- Snorkeling

WHERE IS MY INSURANCE COVER VALID?

You are covered Worldwide for any Diving Injury, within Recreational Diving Limits

HOW DEEP CAN I DIVE?

According to your Diving Certification, but not deeper than 40 meters

Emergency medical evacuation	Total costs up to EUR 50.000,00 in aggregate
Worldwide emergency medical treatment (including home country). Hyperbaric therapy and hospitalization included	Up to EUR 50 per day for a maximum of 5 days
Daily allowance for hospital stay during therapy	Up to EUR 1.000,00
Any prosthesis necessary after an insured injury (on a "claim and pay" basis)	Up to EUR 1.000,00
Search and rescue of the missing diver (cave diving not included)	Up to EUR 5.000,00
Repatriation of the deceased	EUR 1.000,00
